



Charity Auction Rules at Anime Fusion

By bidding in the live or silent auctions, each bidder agrees to these auction rules, and to release contact information (name, phone number, email) only in the event that item(s) won are not paid for and picked up and/or bidder registration information is illegible, incorrect, or missing.

CAUTION! We get art donations. Art comes in many fashions and tastes from small cutie cuddlies to that of a very mature adult nature. Know that we allow everyone in, but some items may have subject matter that may offend or may not be appropriate to all viewers.

Guaranteed Win - Items will have a Guaranteed Win price. An item may be won at that amount any time Friday or Saturday. To make a Guaranteed Win, approach one of the Charity Auction staff members and tell them you would like to Guaranteed Win on an item. Take them to the piece and the staff member will record your badge number and name as a Guaranteed Win purchase. You can pay for it and pick it up then, otherwise the piece will be available for pick-up Sunday morning at which time you will pay for it. Remember, just like bidding this is a contract that is binding.

Rules

- Please register your badge # with auction staff if you bid. **Required to be a valid bid.**
- To bid, print your badge # and bid on the appropriate line **legibly**. To be valid the bid must at least meet the minimum opening bid or increment, indicated at the top of the bid sheet, and Badge number must be registered.
- All bidding must be made by those who are 18 years or older.
- No food or drink is allowed in the auction area.
- Please do not remove or relocate auction items. If you wish to look more closely at an item than placement allows, please seek the assistance of auction staff or volunteers.
- Please refrain from touching fine art or jewelry items.
- Please do not open baskets or boxes/packages.
- Bidding or Guaranteed Win on an auction item is a binding contract with the Geek Partnership Society, you are responsible for payment as the winning bid.
